Join our team and gain the foundational knowledge and understanding for all elements of Business Change."




### **How We Work**

First established in 2016, each year the Business Change Team has expanded to support National Digital Solutions throughout Health Boards & Trusts in Wales transition to new digital ways of working.


Business Change in DHCW encompasses 4 key areas..





#### **Join Our Team**

As a peer group, over the course of the programme you will have the opportunity to share experiences and reflect on your learning.



### Year 1: Foundational

Over your first four weeks you will build a greater understanding of the organisation and business change, with access to experienced professionals within DHCW.

Once you are up to speed, you will be embedded in one of our award winning teams and will undertake the following qualifications:

- Driving Service Excellence Qualification (Level 5)
- Change Ambassador Programme Qualification (Level 6)

# Year 2: Progressional

In year 2, you will have the opportunity to undertake the Coaching for Change Qualification (Level 7).

At 18 months, you will meet with the Head of Business Change to discuss your next career step, which may include:

- Joining a Graduate Scheme\*
- A role in Business Change\*
- Further Education
- Other opportunities\*
